

# **Call for Applications**

Winter School 2021: "Health Data Analytics for the COVID-19 Response"

On behalf of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), the <u>University of Applied</u> <u>Sciences Neu-Ulm (HNU)</u>, in partnership with the <u>University of the Western Cape (UWC)</u>, the <u>Kenya Methodist University (KeMU)</u>, and the <u>Muhimbili University of Health and Allied</u> <u>Sciences (MUHAS)</u>, are organizing a **three-week Online Winter School (part-time)**.

The winter school will be presented in a blended learning format featuring both live online conferences and video lectures **from Saturday**, **16**<sup>th</sup> **October to Saturday**, **6**<sup>th</sup> **November 2021**. The blended learning programme consists of three zoom online conferences on Saturdays, the 16<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> October plus 6<sup>th</sup> November 2021. The main content will be completed autonomously and asynchronously according to the participants' availability. Throughout the three weeks, the programme will feature online group work in combination with practice-orientated online lectures.

The winter school is offered in the ongoing framework of the DAAD programme "Health Data Analytics." Thanks to the funding by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) through the DAAD the participation in the winter school will be free of charge.

#### Objectives

At the end of the winter school, participants will be able to collect, analyse and present data for decision making using "Data Analytics tools and techniques". Participants will receive a certificate of participation, once he/she has attended all the online conferences and successfully completed the group work tasks.

#### Criteria for Participation

The key target group of the winter school are alumni from UWC, KeMU, MUHAS and HNU (only those from developing countries). In addition, alumni from other universities in South Africa, Kenya and Tanzania are eligible to apply.

Requirements for participation:

- A minimum two-year work experience in the health sector dealing with health data;
- A Master or a PhD degree.











### **Application Process**

The application (in English language) should include:

- A one-page description of a health- or healthcare-related problem at your workplace or country that can be solved by using Data Analytics;
- A two-page CV highlighting your experience in the sector;
- A 500-word motivation letter describing why you should be selected for the winter school.

After the review by the local organizing committee, the selected participants will be notified by end of September 2021.
